Lesson 2: Saving Our Wildlife Student Activity Sheet - Adopt an Endangered Species

Now that you're aware that extinction is affecting many species, your activity for today will be to specialize in one specific animal! You can choose any animal that is on the IUCN website and is categorized as endangered for their conservation status. You may need to do some internet research to answer all of the questions!

Step 1: Adopt an endangered species!

Go to iucnredlist.org and search an animal you've been fascinated with or want to learn more about. It can be any animal, but it must be listed as endangered on the IUCN website. Endangered species have a red icon in the bottom right corner that says "EN" on it, signifying it's conservation status. Choose your animal!

Step 2: Find some photos!

You need to show what your animal looks like to your class. Find and choose 2-3 images of your animal to put in

your Google Slides/PowerPoint presentation. The images don't have to be from the IUCN website!	
Step 3:	Become an expert!
